- Find relevant statistics in different data banks to illuminate a policy question.
- Apply statistics to research questions illuminated in the theoretical part of the course

Overall content

The course consists of three integrated parts.

- The first sub-element focuses on theoretical understanding of institutional structures and decision-making patterns in a multi-level context and the contribution of these institutions to governance in a globalised world. This element also looks at different forms of governance in the decision-making process and to public and private actors in transnational governance.
- The second sub-element teaches students to analyse texts produced by different institutions in a multilevel context (e.g. a policy document or an EU directive).
- The third component makes the students familiar with different data such as the European Social Survey and Eurostat data. In addition, students are trained to apply statistical tests to a policy issue.

Teaching and working methods

The teaching alternates between lectures and exercises. In addition, a whole-day interdisciplinary workshop with the other two courses of the semester is included

Individual written take-home assignment given by the lecturer.
